4. Discussion Items

- b. Updates from Housing Colorado Conference and Resource Hub Meeting Resource Hub discussions on co-located structures. Location is still TBD. Conference emphasized the gap in the financial stack due to interest rates.

 c. Update on meetings with Winter Park, Chamber Expo, and Habitat Rob attended the Winter Park work session to introduce FRVHP to the Council Rob also attended the Expo and talked with a variety of business owners Habitat plans for the Land Banking will need some assistance in building units guickly enough to meet the Prop 123 Land Banking timelines.

d. Development opportunities were discussed in terms of how FRVHP can participate. Land acquisition is useful in the long-run and presents a huge opportunity cost with current prices.

Buy Downs are a short term band-aid with some concerns regarding accountability.

Preservation - still need to talk with CHFA and get more information Financial stack gap in coordination with the municipalities.
